The Transformation

The Transformation is a political movement with the sole purpose of uniting Nigerians from across all divides and seizing political power in Nigeria through democratic means to build a great, modern, and prosperous nation based on the centrality of justice, law, and order, using The Green Manifesto and a New Constitution as its twin tools. The Transformation has set a target of capturing at least eighty (80) percent of all elective offices in Nigeria in 2023, including the office of the President. The Transformation believes that only by seizing control of majority of political power across all tiers of government in Nigeria can it lay a strong and decisive foundation needed to usher Nigeria into an era of stability, transparency, and prosperity.

Membership of The Transformation is open to every Nigerian citizen and those legally resident in Nigeria who are eligible to participate in the electoral process. However, every aspiring member of the Transformation must make some denunciations and pledges as contained in the application form. In addition, anyone who has held an elective political position in Nigeria is barred from holding a position of trust and responsibility in The Transformation unless they commit to wholly and fully refunding any funds they may have misappropriated or can demonstrate that they never misappropriated any fund while holding the elective position. The admittance of a Nigerian who has held an appointive political position into a position of trust and responsibility in The Transformation is based on their merit of which their historical financial probity shall be their strongest measure.

Why The Transformation

The Transformation has become necessary because Nigerian politicians have failed spectacularly since Nigerian independence to date to build a cohesive modern nation able to provide justice to its citizens and able to provide a basis for its citizens to fulfil their aspirations. They have bequeathed Nigeria with despondency, desperation, and ruination; collectively and individually pillaging nearly every income Nigeria has earned. More so they continue to position their offspring to continue the wanton destruction of our collective heritage. Therefore, it has become necessary for ordinary Nigerian citizens to seize control of the country to build a country that we both desire and deserve.

Evolution of The Transformation

The Transformation has started as a political movement with the clear intention to morph into a political party within two years of its launch; with the ultimate goal of seizing political power in Nigeria through democratic means. The Transformation aspires to engage with every Nigerian citizen and legal resident with right to electoral participation through a network of volunteers across the country. The target is to have about five (5) million registered members of The Transformation by the time it becomes a political party. This translates roughly to about one hundred and thirty-five thousand members for every state of Nigeria including Abuja. The new political party evolving from The Transformation will go into election with a target of one million registered members in every state of Nigeria including Abuja. This target is to be realised through the "One State, One Million" campaign. This will ensure the widespread understanding and acceptance of the vision of The Transformation across Nigeria.

The Transformation intends that the name, logo, and other trademarks of the new political party to evolve, shall be a collective decision of all the members of The Transformation. A competition shall be run within the movement to make these selections at the appropriate time. It is desired that key decisions within The Transformation shall be made by majority of members and shall have broad support and appeal. The true tenets of democracy shall be the guiding light of The Transformation.

How The Transformation is Organised

The Transformation is organised into a central leadership team, state teams, local government teams, town and villages teams and ward teams. There are also the diaspora teams organised for every city in every country of the world where there is a sizable population of Nigerians. The teams are run by volunteer leaders. The central leadership team has the responsibility of providing guidance and direction to all other teams.

The volunteer leadership teams shall be supported by a network of volunteer campaigners. These volunteer campaigners shall be responsible for driving membership of The Transformation. Volunteer campaigners can also be members of the leadership team. The target is to develop a wide network of volunteer campaigners such that by the time The Transformation goes into election in 2023, every Nigerian or Nigerian resident eligible for electoral participation would have been spoken to and encouraged to register with either The Transformation or the new party that would evolve from The Transformation. This network of volunteer campaigners shall be the backbone of The Transformation.

Every month after the launch of The Transformation, a competition shall be run for volunteer campaigners. The winner shall be the campaigner that generated the highest number of new members for the month. The winner shall be presented with an award for their effort. When The Transformation government is eventually formed, each winner of the monthly membership campaign shall be awarded a national honour in recognition of the role they played in bringing about a new government that ushers in a new era for Nigeria, Africa, and the entire black race. On top of that, the new government shall build a city within Abuja, to be christened the “City of Heroes and Heroines”, where each of these monthly winners shall be immortalised by having a street named after them. This new “City of Heroes and Heroines” shall be dedicated to all those, not just in Nigeria, but in Africa and the entire black race, who have worked hard to genuinely, truly advance the cause of the entire black race.

Funding The Transformation

The Transformation shall be funded by voluntary donations and contributions by its members and other individuals who desire to see Nigeria established as a great, modern, and prosperous nation. Every person donating or contributing to The Transformation must pledge to an undertaking that their donation or contribution is not from money stolen from Nigeria. When The Transformation eventually morphs into a political party, funding of the new party shall be from individual donations and membership dues. Government officials representing the party in government cannot fund the party from government budget.

Accountability in The Transformation

The Transformation is founded on uncompromising integrity and accountability. A record will be kept of every naira realised as revenue by The Transformation. At the end of every year an account shall be prepared for The Transformation. The account should clearly show the revenue to The Transformation and expense by the Transformation. Effort must be made to back up every expense item by a receipt or evidence. And for every expense, it must comply with “Value for Money Principle” as enunciated in The Green Manifesto Procurement Policy.

Every paid position that becomes available either in The Transformation or the new party that shall evolve, must be advertised to members of The Transformation or the new party. Only the most

qualified candidate for the role shall be recruited in line with the National Merit Policy of The Transformation as stated in The Green Manifesto.
